



Scout Camping in Tents

Save paper - retain for future reference.

What to bring to camp

- **Scout uniform** to be worn to and from camp.
- **Soft sports/duffle/travel bag** containing items listed below. Everything fits in an 60/80L bag.
- **Small daypack** for water bottle, waterproof jacket/poncho, personal first aid kit.
- **Personal Information and Health form.** Completed by parent and **MUST** be brought with scout to camp. Scouts without a completed form will not be allowed to attend camp. Haven't got one? Download one from the group website www.5thbrunswickscouts.org.au.

Clothing

- 1x warm waterproof/windproof jacket
- 1x tracksuit/polar fleece long-sleeve top and pants.
- 1x shorts
- 1x t-shirt
- 2x socks
- 1x change of underwear (underpants and singlet)
- optional – thermals (undershirt and/or long johns)
- optional - gloves/mitts (wool, thinsulate)
- 1x sun hat (broad brim)
- 1x beanie (wool, polarfleece or thinsulate)
- 1x poncho (waterproof nylon)
- 1pr sound sturdy closed-toe footwear (trainers, bush boots, etc)
- optional - thongs (for showering only)

Equipment

- Pillow – small sized camp pillow is easiest to carry
- Sleeping bag
- Foam sheet or “Thermarest”-style self-inflating mattress to sleep on.
- optional – camp bed (stretcher)
- optional – camp blanket
- optional - inner sheet

Eating Utensils

- Plate, bowl, mug in melamine or steel
- Knife, fork& spoon (stainless steel).
- Dilly bag for eating gear

Personal (in your daypack)

- Personal first aid kit
- Pen and notepad
- Water bottle
- Small torch
- Sunscreen
- Lip balm
- Toiletries bag containing soap in a soap box, tooth brush, toothpaste, comb/hairbrush
- Towel
- optional - insect repellent



Sports or duffel bag and a daypack is best for bringing gear to a standing camp. Pack **EVERYTHING** into these one or two bags. Individual items (sleeping bags, mats, dilly bags) can easily get damaged or lost.

If you do not know what any of these items are, please ask your patrol leader or your section leader.

EVERYTHING must be labelled with your name.
NO electronic games or mobile phones.
Sweets and additional snacks or drinks are discouraged.
